O R D E R

1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Having regard to all the attending circumstances, and taking notice of the fact that it is not necessary to issue notice to the respondents, we deem it appropriate to modify the impugned order dated 06.02.2025, passed by the High Court of Judicature at Madras, to the extent that if the petitioner deposits a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh) with the Registrar General of the High Court within two weeks, the purported PIL filed by him may be listed for hearing on merits. Ordered accordingly.
