UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1 The petitioner seeks leave to challenge the order
dated 19.12.2024 passed by the High Court of Punjab and
Haryana at Chandigarh in CRM-M-64349 of 2024.

2. In connection with FIR No. 53 dated 28.11.2024
registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Patiala

Range, Patiala, the anticipatory bail application of the petitioner was rejected by the High Court vide impugned order.

3. This Court, while issuing notice on 15.01.2025, directed that no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioner.

4. Having heard learned counsel for the parties, and perused the material placed on record, it is directed that in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he be released on anticipatory bail subject to the reasonable terms and conditions in accordance with law, to be imposed by the Investigating Officer.

5. Needless to add that the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called for by the Investigating Officer.

6. Liberty is reserved to the State to move an appropriate application before the Trial Court seeking cancellation of bail should the need so arise, considering the conduct of the petitioner.

7. The special leave petition is accordingly disposed of.
