O R D E R

1. The petitioner challenges the final judgment and order dated 07.11.2024 in S.B. Criminal Miscellaneous 4th Bail Application No.11456/2024 passed by the High Court of Judicature for Rajasthan, Bench at Jaipur.
2. The petitioner and four(04) others have been arrested in connection with Crime No.87 of 2023 of Suket Police Station, Kota Rural, Rajasthan.
3. It is not in dispute that co-accused in the said crime have already been enlarged on bail. The petitioner was arrested on
