O R D E R

1. Leave granted.

2. Appellant challenges the judgment and order dated 10.12.2024, 23.12.2024 & 02.01.2025 in CO.3406/2024 passed by the High Court at Calcutta, titled "*Sukanya Das vs. Arindam Das*".

3. A joint application being I.A. No. 211627/2025 seeking appropriate directions under Article 142 of the Constitution of India for dissolving their marriage by way of mutual consent as per the terms of the settlement arrived at between the parties.

4. Appellant - Arindam Das, who is present through video conferencing, and Respondent - Sukanya Das, who is physically present before this Court, have been identified by their respective learned counsel.

5. Learned counsel appearing for the parties submit that all the disputes and differences between the parties stand amicably resolved, and the parties have decided to happily part ways on

terms and conditions as contained in the Joint Application. Accordingly, appropriate and necessary orders may be passed in accordance therewith.

6. Parties undertake to adhere all terms of the settlement, more so, paragraph nos.3.2 & 3.3 thereof, stipulating vacating the property and purchase of another apartment. Parties through their counsel have been made aware of the consequences of breach of undertaking.

7. It is further agreed between the parties that as per paragraph no.2(e) of the Joint Application, the cases mentioned therein, as described below, shall be closed:

"2(e). Due to disputes and differences between the Applicants, several cases had been filed by the Applicants against each other and family members. The following cases are presently pending, to the best of the Applicants' knowledge:

(i) Complaint bearing No. C-130/2013 titled "Sukanya Das vs Arindam Das & Anr.", pending before the Ld. Judicial Magistrate, at Bidhan Nagar Court.

(ii) Matrimonial Suit bearing No. 157 of 2014 (renumbered as Matrimonial Suit No. 49076 of 2014) titled "Arindam Das vs Sukanya Das", pending before the Ld. Additional District Judge, Fast Track Court No.3 at Barasat, 24 Parganas (North).

(iii) Contempt Petition bearing Crl. CP. No. 1 of 2021 titled "Arindam Das vs Sukanya Das", pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta

(iv) Civil Revisional Application bearing C.O. No.2217 of 2022 titled "Sukanya Das vs Arindam Das", pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta.

(v) Civil Revisional Application bearing

C.O. No.2768 of 2024 titled "Arindam Das vs Sukanya Das", pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta.

(vi) Civil Revisional Application bearing C.O. No.3406 of 2024 titled "Sukanya Das vs Arindam Das", pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta."

8. In view of the above, the following directions are issued:

i) the judgment and order dated 10.12.2024, 23.12.2024 & 02.01.2025 in CO.3406/2024 passed by the High Court at Calcutta, titled "*Sukanya Das vs. Arindam Das*", are set aside;

ii) the marriage solemnized on 25.11.1998 between the appellant/husband-Arindam Das and the respondent/wife-Sukanya Das having broken down irretrievably is hereby dissolved by a decree of divorce by mutual consent;

iii) all the legal proceedings mentioned above, pending *inter se* the parties shall stand closed/quashed; also, the allegations and counter allegations made by the parties to the *lis* shall be deemed to have been withdrawn and expunged from the records of the *lis inter se* the parties.

iv) decree be drawn up accordingly;

v) it goes without saying that both the parties will continue to abide by the terms of the settlement without any exception;

vi) the Registry is directed to forward a copy of this order to the foras/Courts concerned for passing formal orders closing the cases/placing the same on the

record of the file(s); and,

vii) the terms of the settlement which are mentioned in paragraph no.3 of the Joint application shall remain part and parcel of this order.

9. We record our appreciation for the reasonable stand taken by the parties, as well as the cooperation extended by their respective counsel.

10. In view of the above facts, I.A. No. 211627 OF 2025 is allowed and the appeals stand disposed of.

11. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
