O R D E R

1. We have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record.

2. Learned counsel for the parties submitted that all the disputes and differences between the parties have been amicably resolved, and the parties have decided to part ways on certain terms and conditions. Accordingly, appropriate and necessary orders may be passed in accordance therewith.

3. We appreciate the efforts put in by Ms. Upma Srivastava, learned Co-Mediator; Mr. Ajit Kumar Pathak, learned Co-Mediator; and Mr. Dvijendra Kumar Pandey, learned Mediator, Supreme Court of India, as well as the learned counsel for the parties in helping the parties arrive at an amicable settlement. The Settlement Agreement dated 03.09.2025 is placed on record.

4. It is further agreed between the parties that, as per paragraph no.2 of the Settlement Agreement, the cases mentioned therein, as described below, shall stand closed:

"2. That the following cases are pending between the parties:-

(1) Maintenance Case No. 177 of 2023 pending before Family Court, Aurangabad, Bihar filed by the Petitioner.

(ii) FIR No. 5137076240007 dated 26.01.2024 lodged in Women P.S. Aurangabad, Bihar filed by the Petitioner against the Respondent & Ors.

(iii) Crl. Revision Petition No. 339 of 2025 pending before Hon'ble High Court of Patna.

(iv) Divorce Petition bearing No. 3598 of 2025 titled Ravi Pandey Vs. Rani Kumari pending before Principal Judge, Family Court, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh.

(v) Execution Case No. 122 of 2025 pending before Aurangabad filed by the Petitioner in Maintenance Case No. 177/2023 pending before Family Court, Aurangabad, Bihar.

vi) Crime No. 0437 of 2023 dated 22.10.2023 U/s 498-A and 323 of I.P.C in filed in P. S. Madivala, Bangalore filed by the Petitioner, converted into C. C. No. 6752 of 2024 pending before ACMM Bengaluru.

The parties agrees to make a joint request to the Hon'ble Supreme Court to quash aforesaid cases. In the event of such order is not passed then the parties undertakes to withdraw their respective cases as earliest and shall render full cooperation to each other in this regard."

5. In view of the above, the following directions are issued:

i) The marriage solemnized on 29.04.2018 between the petitioner-wife and the respondent-husband is hereby dissolved by a decree of divorce by mutual consent;

ii) All the legal proceedings pending *inter se* the parties, as indicated above (paragraph no.4 herein), shall stand closed;

iii) Decree be drawn up accordingly;

iv) It goes without saying that both parties will continue to abide by the terms of the Settlement Agreement without any exception;

v) Registry is directed to forward a copy of this order to the Forum(s)/Court(s) concerned for passing formal orders closing the cases;

vi) The Settlement Agreement dated 03.09.2025 is made part of this order, and its terms are binding upon the parties. Parties undertake to abide by the same; and

vii) Parties, through their learned counsel present in the Court, have been made aware of the consequences of breach of such terms, including the initiation of contempt proceedings.

6. In view of the above facts, the Transfer Petition is disposed of.

7. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
