O R D E R

1. Leave granted.
2. Learned senior counsel for the appellants submitted that the alleged occurrence was in the year 2013. There was a subsequent development in which the informant had also participated. There was an earlier complaint given by the mother on the same set of allegations which was closed.
3. Learned counsel appearing for the State submitted that the appellants have been charged for the offence punishable under Sections 406,

419, 420, 465, 468, 471 and 506(1) of IPC. The appellants have not been cooperating with the investigation so far.

4. By way of a reply, the learned senior counsel appearing for the appellants submitted that the said submission is not factually correct.

5. Be that as it may, even on a prima facie view, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail, particularly considering the fact that the alleged occurrence took place nearly a decade ago. The earlier complaint given by the mother was closed.

6. In such view of the matter, impugned order(s) stand set aside and the appellants are granted bail on such terms and conditions which are to the satisfaction of the trial Court, and also subject to their cooperation with the investigation.

7. The appeals stand allowed accordingly.

8. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
