O R D E R

By an order dated 05.03.2021, this Court referred the above matter to the Supreme Court Mediation Centre. The parties have reached a settlement agreement on 19.07.2021 before the Mediation Centre. The settlement agreement reads as follows:-

"SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This Settlement Agreement is entered into between Petitioner No.1 Ms. Anju Singh, w/o. Late Shri Shubham Kumar Singh, and Baby Raavya Singh (Minor) (through her mother Anju Singh) R/o. Flat No.245/G Block, Nobel Residency Road, Pariwar Passion Apartment, 5<sup>th</sup> Cross Doda Kamanahalle Main Road, District-Bangalore, Karnataka.

AND

Respondent No.1, Dr. Rajdeo Prasad Singh, S/o Late Shri Radha Singh R/o Flat No.1/D, Shivroop Kutir, P.S. Budha Colony Town Patna Bihar and Respondent No.2, Mrs. Veena Singh W/o Shri Rajdeo Prasad Singh, Flat No.1/D, Shivroop Kutir, P.S. Budha Colony Town, District Patna, District - Patna, Bihar and Presently R/o Civil Surgeon Quarters, District/town Sheohar, Bihar.

The Hon'ble Supreme Court vide its order dated 05.03.2021 was pleased to refer the matter to Mediation Centre, Supreme Court.

Comprehensive mediation sessions were held with the parties separately and jointly on today i.e. on 15.03.2021, 06.04.2021, 16.04.2021, 04.05.2021, 12.06.2021 and today i.e. 19.07.2021.

1. That the both the parties have entered into a full and final settlement agreement in respect of the case which is pending, filed by the Respondent-grandparents, which is GC No.51 of 2019 pending before the Principal Judge, Family Court, Patna, Bihar. The Respondent shall withdraw the aforesaid petition within fifteen days for signing of this Settlement Agreement.

2. That it is hereby agreed that the Petitioner-mother shall have the custody of the minor child Raavya Singh. The Petitioner has agreed that the Respondent No.1 and 2 grandparents of the Petitioner No. 2 i.e. Raavya Singh is entitled the Physical visit once in a month for One hour i.e. 4:00 PM to 5:00 PM 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of every month. As considering the current pandemic situation, in place of personal visit, zoom call for 30 minutes will be allowed.

3. After pandemic, the grandparents will be allowed to meet the petitioner No.2 in presence of Petitioner no.1 at Mata ka Mandir, in Ramchandrapur Village Gopalganj, Bihar subject to sharing latest Corona Test report as the party is a medical practitioner. In case of any party is in any difficulty they may intimate 15 days before the date fixed for meeting and decide the fresh date.

4. That once the Petitioners shifts to Bangalore, her work place, the Respondents will meet the Petitioner No.2 in presence of Petitioner No.1 at Meenakeshi Mall, Bamerghatta Road, Bangalore.

5. It is agreed between the parties not to exchange messages and call from him and his relatives on Petitioners number or any of Petitioner relative's phone number.

6. It is agreed between the parties that not to share of gifts including food items or any article with Petitioner No.2. That the grandparents will not visit at the residence of Petitioner No.1 and 2, office, school, coaching classes, activity classes and relatives of the Petitioners.

7. It is agreed between the parties that the parties undertakes not to interfere in their life or each other or their family members by any means whatsoever. Both parties hereby undertake not to subject each other to any physical, mental abuse or trauma by way of interference in each other.

8. That it is agreed between the parties that in case of failure or non adherence on the part of either of the parties, either party has right to approach/seek redressal with regard to such non-adherence in appropriate forum/Court of Law.

9. By signing this Agreement the parties hereto solemnly state and affirm that all the disputes and differences

have been amicably settled by the parties hereto through the process of mediation.

10. The parties undertake to abide by the terms and conditions set out in the above mentioned Agreement, which have been arrived without any coercion, duress or collusion and undertake not to raise any dispute whatsoever till the circumstances changes."

In view of the above, the transfer petition is disposed of and the parties shall adhere to the terms and conditions of the settlement.

Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
