O R D E R

I.A. No.11618/2025

This application has been filed by the petitioner herein seeking a direction to respondent no.3/institution to release all his original documents and a direction to respondent no.4/University to issue a provisional certificate for the purpose of seeking admission to a post-graduate course in general category.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has already participated in the counseling held by the State of Maharashtra and is awaiting result for the purpose of seeking admission to a post-graduate Medical College. However, his original documents have been withheld by the respondent institution and the University has not issued any provisional degree certificate to the petitioner.

We have heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
