O R D E R

Heard counsel on either side.

We notice that the respondent was working as Headmistress from the year 1983 to 1997. In the year 1997 the school was given recognition, but she was made only as Teacher-in-charge and not as Headmistress. In such circumstances, she approached the High Court and the High Court allowed the writ petition and gave a direction to the petitioner to grant all benefits which are legally admissible to such post of Headmistress with effect from 1.5.1997. Since the respondent has been working in the school, earlier as Headmistress or as Teacher-in-charge from the year 1983 onwards, the High Court is right in granting her the relief.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, we find no reason to interfere with the order of the High Court and accordingly, the special leave petition is dismissed.

We make it clear that it shall not be treated as a precedent.
