O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. We have heard learned learned Senior Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner-State at a considerable length and carefully perused the material placed on record.
- 3 In view of the fact that respondent No.1 served the State from 15.04.1978 till 30.09.2012; he possessed the requisite

qualification as prescribed at the relevant time for the post he held; the alleged adverse reports were not communicated to him and coupled with the fact that the benefit of regularisation has been granted by the High Court to various similarly placed persons, we see no reason to interfere with the impugned orders dated 05.10.2023 and 20.02.2023, passed by the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad, Lucknow Bench, Lucknow.

4. The Special Leave Petitions are, accordingly, dismissed.
5. As a result, the pending interlocutory application also stands disposed of.
