ORDER

1. The petitioner-wife has filed the present petition under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 seeking transfer of a petition for divorce filed by the respondent-husband under Section 13(1)(i-a) and 25 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 bearing FCOP No.302 of 2023 titled "**K. Karthi Vs. S. Shilpa**" pending before the Family Court at Vellore, Tamil Nadu to the Family Court, Bengaluru, Karnataka.
2. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and on examining the grounds taken in the transfer petition, we direct transfer of FCOP No.302 of 2023 titled "**K. Karthi Vs. S. Shilpa**" pending before the Family Court at Vellore, Tamil Nadu to the Family Court, Bengaluru, Karnataka.
3. The record of the case be transferred immediately to the transferee Court.
4. Further, liberty is granted to the respondent-husband to move an appropriate application before the transferee Court for permission to participate in the proceedings virtually. If such a request is made, the transferee Court may grant such permission and direct the personal presence of the respondent-husband only when it

is absolutely necessary. Further, if examination of the outstation witnesses is required and a request is made for recording the evidence through a Court Commissioner, the transferee Court shall consider the same and pass appropriate orders.

5. The Transfer Petition is allowed on the above terms. Pending application is disposed of.
