O R D E R

Criminal Case No.2025 of 2011 under Sections 323, 427, 507 and 506 of IPC was registered at Police Station Kotwali, Dehradun against the petitioners on a complaint made by the complainant Taraun Kantrar/respondent no.2. During the pendency of this petition, the parties have settled the issues because they are next

door neighbours and filed an application for permission of this Court to compound the offences. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant has no objection if this Court grants permission and quash the criminal proceedings initiated on the complaint of the complainant.

Learned counsel for the State of Uttarakhand has stated across the Bar that all the offences are compoundable with the permission of this Court and this Court may pass the appropriate orders.

Considering the aforesaid, as the dispute has been settled and the complainant does not want to proceed in the matter, therefore, by granting the permission of compounding, proceedings pending in the Criminal Case No.2025/2011 with respect to Case Crime No.69/2011 before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Dehradun is hereby quashed. The bail bond(s), if any, is hereby cancelled and the sureties are discharged.

The Special Leave Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
