O R D E R

1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and carefully perused the material placed on record.
2. We are informed that the main case, i.e., Writ Petition No.105448 of 2019, has already been finally heard by the High Court and the judgment has been reserved on 19.11.2025.
3. The instant Contempt Petition is, accordingly, disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the High Court through an appropriate application in the pending Writ Petition, as the High Court is better equipped to verify the allegations/cross-allegations, if so required. We, therefore, do not express any opinion on the merits of the contempt proceedings and leave it to the wisdom of the High Court to issue appropriate directions.

resolved as soon as the judgment reserved by the High Court is pronounced.
