UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. These Special Leave Petitions are directed against the order dated 27.10.2022 passed by the High Court for the State of Telangana at Hyderabad in Writ Petition Nos. 23420/2022 and 35173/2022 and order dated 20.12.2024 in Contempt Case CC No. 1642 of 2024.
2. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the respondents, we are of the opinion that the direction of the High Court, to the extent that it has ordered transfer of the PG Seat of MD DVL course from MNR Medical College to the Medicity Medical College is impermissible in law. In this view of the matter, the order to this extent is set aside.
4. In the facts and circumstances of the case, we direct the University to treat Respondent No.1 (Dr. Ganta Sathvika Reddy) as a student of Medicity Medical College.
5. The amount deposited by Respondent No. 1 in the University shall be made over to MNR Medical College, which will, in turn, grant the No Objection Certificate to Respondent No. 1.
6. In view of above, Respondent No. 1 will be permitted to apply to the Medicity Medical College and can appear in the examination.
7. With these directions, the Special Leave Petitions stand disposed of.

8. Pending interlocutory application(s), if any, is/are disposed of.
