O R D E R

Permission to file SLP is granted.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

The petitioner is having a tannery factory at Kanpur near

the Ganges and the petitioner alleges that the tannery factory has
been working since 1945. The High Court in a Public Interest

Litigation filed before it directed to close down several tannery
factories which had been polluting the waters of the Ganges. The
Petitioner's tannery factory was also closed down accordingly. The
petitioner contends that he has already installed Sewerage Treatment
Plant(STP) and his tannery factory is not causing any pollution to
Ganga. The petitioner made an attempt to get itself impleaded in
the pending matter but the High Court rejected the same and has not

considered and petitioner's application.

We direct that the petitioner be heard in the pending matter and appropriate orders may be passed. The petitioner's application for impleadment be considered and appropriate order be passed at the earliest at least within a period of three months.

The special leave petition is disposed of accordingly.
