O R D E R

In this miscellaneous application, the applicant has prayed for the following reliefs:-

"a. Allow the present application and replace and rectify the first paragraph of the Order dated 28th November 2023 in SLP (C) Nos.25783-25784 of 2023 with the words;

'An earlier Special Leave Petition by the Company SLP (C) Diary No. 45529 of 2023 [Bharat Nidhi Limited vs Ashok Dayabhai Shah and Others] has been dismissed by this Court on 6 November 2023.'; and

b. Pass any such further orders/directions which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the present case."

We heard Dr. Abhishek Manu Singhvi, the learned senior counsel appearing for the applicants and Mr. Saket Sikri, the learned counsel appearing for the respondents.

We take notice of the order passed by this Court dated 28.11.2023 wherein, it has been recorded that an earlier special leave petition by one of the promoters has been dismissed by this Court. This according to the learned counsel appearing for the parties has been inadvertently recorded because the earlier SLP was not filed by a promoter but was filed by the Company.

In such circumstances, the relief as prayed for in this miscellaneous application is granted.

M.A. Nos. 227-228/2024 stand disposed of with the aforesaid clarification.
