Even on merits, we are convinced that the finding
recorded by the lower appellate court that 13 kanals 14 marlas of
land was an ancestral property in the hands of Om Parkash (father
of the respondent) was based on correct appreciation of pleadings
and evidence produced by the parties and the High Court rightly
declined to entertain the second appeal preferred by the
petitioner.

With the above observation, the Special Leave Petition
is dismissed.
