2. Heard Mr. Kumar Shivam, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners. Also heard Mr. K.M. Natraj, the Ld. ASG appearing for the respondent.

4. Accordingly, if the Police wish to arrest the petitioners (Ashutosh Bishwas and Mrinmay Goldar) in connection with the case arising out of FIR No.210/2014, upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/-, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer, they shall be released on bail.

5. However, the Petitioners are expected to appear regularly before the Court.

6. With the above order, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of. Pending application(s), if any, stand closed.
