UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present special leave petition and states that the petitioner - M/s. Deepak Vegpro Private Limited will raise all pleas and contentions before the High Court, where the rectification application/petition is pending.

Having considered the statement made and in the facts and

circumstances of the case, we allow the petitioner - M/s. Deepak Vegpro Private Limited to withdraw the special leave petition with liberty as prayed.

We clarify that the observations made in the impugned judgment will not come in the way of the petitioner - M/S. Deepak Vegpro Private Limited and the respondent - M/s. The special leave petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed and with the aforesaid clarification.
