**UPON hearing the counsel
the Court made the following
O R D E R**

- 1) Against an order of rejection of regular bail by the High Court and to seek bail, the present special leave petition has been filed. The petitioner is in custody w.e.f.18.02.2024 in connection with FIR No.71 of 2024 dated 17.02.2024 for the offences punishable under Sections 394, 395, 120B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, and under Sections 4/25 of the Arms Act, registered with Police Station Dharangaon, District Jalgaon.
- 2) After hearing learned counsel

for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case wherein the petitioner is in custody since last about two years, charges have been framed on 13.02.2025 and out of 25, none of the witnesses has yet been examined, however, early conclusion of trial is not possible. Considering the aforesaid, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, we deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on bail.

3) Accordingly, we direct to release the petitioner on bail on furnishing the suitable bail bonds and sureties and on such other terms and conditions as may be deemed fit by the trial Court.

4) Petitioner to abide all the conditions as imposed and shall regularly attend the trial until exempted by the Court. Violation, if any, may give a cause to take recourse as permissible and the trial Court is at liberty to do the needful.

5) Accordingly, and in view of the foregoing, the special leave petition stands allowed. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
