O R D E R

After having heard learned counsel for the parties, we are not inclined to interfere with the impugned judgment and order passed by the High Court. The Special Leave Petition, accordingly, stands dismissed.

However, considering the facts and circumstances, six months time from today is allowed to the petitioner to vacate and handover peaceful possession of the premises in dispute to the

petitioner subject to an undertaking being filed within a period of three weeks from today before this court.

The petitioner shall also be under liability to deposit the damages for use and occupation during this period at the rate of Rs. 3735/- per month on or before seventh of each month regularly and without any default before the executing court. The respondent/landlord shall be entitled to withdraw the amount so deposited. In case of default, the petitioner shall be liable to be evicted forthwith.
