**ORDER**

1 Delay condoned.

2 Leave granted.

3 On 1 April 2022, the following order was passed by this Court:

“1 The first and second petitioners who stand convicted for an offence punishable under Sections 302 and 307 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code 1860 and Section



25 of the Arms Act 1959 are stated to have undergone imprisonment for a term over 15 years 9 months without remission and 19 years 11 months with remission and 15 years 9 months without remission and 19 years 5 months with remission, respectively.

- 2 Issue notice on the application for condonation of delay and on the Special Leave Petition.
  - 3 Liberty to serve the Standing Counsel for the State of Uttar Pradesh, in addition.
  - 4 List the Special Leave Petitions on 22 April 2022.”
- 4 In pursuance of the above order, Mr Ardhendumauli Kumar Prasad, Additional Advocate General for the State of Uttar Pradesh has appeared.
  - 5 As the above order indicates, the appellants have undergone a sentence of over 15 years and 9 months without remission. Since the appeal before the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad is unlikely to be heard at an early date, we order and direct that the appellants shall be released on bail subject to such terms and conditions as may be imposed by the Sessions Court in connection with Sessions Trial No 605 of 2006.
  - 6 The appellants shall cooperate in the expeditious disposal of the appeal before the High Court.
  - 7 The appeals are accordingly disposed of.



8 Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
