O R D E R

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties, the averments made in the transfer petition, and in the interest of justice, we allow the transfer petition.

Accordingly, Petition No. 438 of 2021 titled "V.P. Singh @ Vipin vs. Arzoo" pending in the Family Court, Bharatpur, Rajasthan is directed to be transferred to the Court of Presiding Officer at Family Court, Hodal, Haryana, who may hear the case himself or assign it to a court of competent jurisdiction.

Records of the case would be immediately transferred to the transferee court.

To cut short delay, parties are directed to appear in person, through an authorized representative or through video-conferencing if the said facility is available, before the transferee court on 12.01.2023. The transferee court would decide the matter expeditiously.
