O R D E R

The present petition has been filed by the de-facto complainant for quashing of the anticipatory bail granted to

respondent no. 1 herein by the High Court by order dated 16.08.2021.

After the FIR, at the instance of the present petitioner, came to be registered for offence under Section 376 IPC, the charge sheet came to be filed upon completion of investigation on 15.07.2020 and after framing of charge, 7 prosecution witnesses including the complainant-PW2, her mother-PW3 and Doctor-PW1 along with other prosecution witnesses have been examined.

It is not the case of the petitioner that respondent No. 1 herein made any attempt to influence the petitioner or any other prosecution witness and anticipatory bail was granted to him on 16.08.2021.

In the given facts and circumstances, we are not inclined to interfere in the order impugned not because there is no merit in the petition but on account of changed circumstances brought to the notice of this Court. Consequently, the special leave petition stands dismissed.

However, we direct the Trial Court to conclude the trial as expeditiously as possible.
