



UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

The predicament the petitioner finds himself in, is of its own making. Learned Solicitor General makes an impassioned plea only seeking extension of time to deposit the amount so as to not to face consequences as envisaged by the Bombay High Court by the impugned order. On our specific queries, it is stated that four weeks' time may be granted as a last opportunity.

Learned senior counsel for the respondent(s) on instructions is fair enough to state that he will not come in the way if the aforesaid time is granted.

We, thus, grant four weeks' time to the petitioner to deposit the balance amount, as a last opportunity and that too very reluctantly, whereafter the Bombay High Court is free to proceed with the consequences envisaged under the impugned order.

The special leave petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.

Pending applications also stand disposed of.
