O R D E R

This Special Leave Petition is filed against an order passed by the High Court refusing to interfere with the order passed by the Family Court by which interim maintenance of Rs.5,000/- per month was granted to the respondent-wife. The direction of the Family Court is to pay maintenance from the date of filing of the application.

Though we are not inclined to interfere with the judgment and order passed by the High Court, however, we accept the submission of Mr. Amit Anand Tiwari, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and grant one year time to clear the arrears of interim maintenance, which according to him is Rs.2,45,000/-. Mr. Tiwari, learned counsel further submits that an attempt can be made to settle the dispute between the parties by the Trial Court.

The special leave petition is, accordingly, dismissed. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
