UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Application seeking exemption from filing official translation of the Annexures is allowed.

2. Heard learned Senior appearing for the petitioner, learned Deputy Advocate General appearing for the State of Madhya Pradesh and perused the material available on record, including the counter affidavit filed by the State.

3. Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner is reported to be in jail since 17-8-2021 and thus suffered incarceration for around 1 year, the co-accused have already been released on bail and there being no likelihood of completion of trial in the near future, which fact cannot be controverted by the learned Deputy Advocate General appearing for the State, we are inclined to enlarge him on bail.

4. The petitioner is, therefore, directed to be released on bail, subject to such terms & conditions which the concerned Trial Court shall deem fit and find appropriate to impose upon him.

5. With the above observation, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of.
