In that view, hearing the learned counsel for the respondent as well, we grant time to the petitioners to vacate and handover vacant possession on or before 31st December, 2023, subject to filing an undertaking in this regard in the Registry of this Court within four weeks, to voluntary vacate and handover possession on the said date and also to pay rents as fixed by the High Court regularly during the period of stay in the premises.
