O R D E R

Leave granted.

We have heard learned counsel appearing for the appellant and learned counsels appearing for the respondent-State and for the complainant.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the parties have entered into a compromise and the prosecutrix does not want to press the charges. Our attention has been drawn to Annexure P-4 which is a compromise deed entered into between the petitioner and the prosecutrix. Paragraph 3, 4 and 5 of said compromise deed reads as under:-

"3. That Party No. 2 is of the age of 24 years and the party no. 1 is married, having a small kid of age of 12 years keeping in view the young age of the party no. 2 and her future prospects and the welfare of the family and the little kid of the party no. 1, both the parties have agreed to enter into

compromise and lead their peaceful life and to avoid the process of litigation.

4. That now the elders and respectable of the society of both the parties, entered into a compromise. The compromise has been affected without any undue influence or coercion and on the free will of the party no. 2.

5. That now the complainant party no. 2 do not have any kind of objection if the abovesaid FIR will quashed, she is ready to give any kind of statement before any court of law for the cancellation or quashing of any litigation against party no. 1 regarding the abovesaid FIR.

It is submitted that since the parties have entered into a compromise and since the prosecutrix herself is not supporting the prosecution case even if the trial is permitted to go ahead, it will end in acquittal.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant does not dispute the fact that the parties have entered into a compromise and the prosecutrix is not interested in proceedings with the prosecution.

In view of the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, the impugned order dated 15.12.2022 passed by the High Court of Punjab and Haryana at Chandigarh, is hereby quashed.

The appellant is held entitled to anticipatory bail. In such circumstances, it is provided that in case the appellant is arrested, he shall be released on bail forthwith on such terms and conditions as may be deemed fit and appropriate by the learned Trial Court/Investigating agency.

The appeal is allowed accordingly. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
