Leave granted.

We have heard learned counsel appearing for the appellant and also learned counsel appearing for respondent Nos.1 and 2. The learned Single Judge is seized of the Writ Petition filed by respondent Nos.1 and 2. After having perused the impugned order passed by the Division Bench of the High Court, we are of the view that the directions issued thereunder were not at all warranted by way of interim relief.

We, therefore, set aside the impugned judgment dated 29.11.2024. We dispose of the appeal while keeping open all the questions on merits in the pending Writ Petition before the learned Single Judge.

In the event the appellants desire to arrest respondent Nos.1 and 2, they shall give 15 days clear notice in advance.

In the meanwhile, as and when called upon, respondent Nos.1 and 2 shall cooperate for the investigation. Appeal bearing No.MAT 2071/2024 is disposed of. The learned Single Judge is free to proceed with the Writ Petition filed by respondent Nos.1 and 2. In

the facts of the case, it is not necessary for us to decide the issue of maintainability of the appeal. The issue is kept open.

The Appeal stands disposed of accordingly.
