O R D E R

1. Exemption Applications are allowed.
2. The Court has heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material placed on record.

3. The record indicates that investigation has not been completed as yet. In the meanwhile, High Court for the State of Telangana at Hyderabad, has granted relief by way of permitting the petitioner to travel abroad, but at the same time required him to return by 25-09-2023.

4. This Court is of the opinion that the respondent should expedite and complete the investigation and in the meanwhile, the permission given by the High Court which expires on 26-09-2023, is hereby extended to 30-10-2023. This is, however, subject to the petitioner approaching the High Court, with a suitable application.

5. The High Court is requested to take up that application at its earliest convenience within a week from filing it. The petitioner shall in turn file the application not later than two weeks from today.

6. The Special Leave Petition is disposed of in above-terms.

7. Pending application is also disposed of.
